Most of the sheet music found today is produced from the 1890s onwards. Early examples featured favorite songs from popular stage productions. Later, film and radio introduced popular music to more American homes. Entertainers associated with original versions of these songs are often depicted on musical covers, a side benefit for today's gatherers as a crossover into pop culture memorabilia. This type of ephemera was in such demand back in the day that many examples sold more than a million copies when it was first issued. Collecting Paper by Gene Uz (Collecting Book—now out of print, available through a used bookstore) reports that Birds in a Gilded Cage sold two million copies in 1900. In 1910, the regular songs Let Me Call You Sweetheart and Down By the Old Mill Stream sold five to six million copies each. Any professional musician that day would have a heap of colorful sheet music arranged on a piano stool and stuck in a box. Musicians are home to traders selling sheet music for use in homespun entertainment as well, especially during leave. Early 20th-century personalities such as Al Jolson, Fannie Brice and Eddie Cantor grabbed many early sheet music issues. Later, 1940s stars such as Bing Crosby and Dorothy Lamour were enthusiasts on colorful covers depicted. Even sheet music from The Beatles, The Beach Boys and other more recent issues exposing pop culture icons, such as Michael Jackson, is collected today. More recognizable stars and songs most often hold the most value with a few exceptions to rarely sheer or interesting cover illustrations.
